

203.2 ORDER OF SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at school board meetings.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

III. ORDER OF REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:

1. Call to order.
2. Approval of agenda.
3. Recognition of delegations and individuals.
4. District Points of Pride.
5. Consent agenda.
6. Reports and Discussion items.
7. Action items.
8. Information and report items; Superintendent's announcements; School Board member reports.
9. Handouts for the School Board.
10. Adjournment.

B. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.

IV. ORDER OF SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

- A. The school board will follow an agenda developed by the school board chair and superintendent. The agenda will reflect the need of the special meeting and follow an agenda order similar to:
1. Call to order.
 2. Approval of agenda.
 3. Recognition of delegations and individuals.
 4. Reports and Discussion items.
 5. Action items.
 6. Adjournment.
- B. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
