We are pleased to announce under the Governor's Executive Order 20-02, version March 25, 2020, **FREE** childcare (4-12 years old) is available during the regular school day. This now includes **emergency workers, Tier 1 critical workers, Tier 2!** Other workers may also use the childcare option for a fee.

Please contact your HR department to determine if you qualify under the Governor's Executive Order 20-02, version March 25, 2020. **Please see the attached for further clarification.**

When will care begin for critical care childcare, Tier 2?

Monday, March 30

Will care be available on regularly scheduled non-school days?

Yes, but a fee will incur.

What is the cost of the program?

Tier 1 Emergency Workers and Tier 2 Defined Critical Workers

There is NO COST during normal school hours; 7:30am-2:30pm
6:30-7:30am and 2:30-5:30pm are at a fee.

AM Care (6:30-7:30 am): \$3/day

School Hours (7:30 am-2:30 pm): \$0/day

PM Care (2:30-5:30 pm): \$7/day

ALL OTHER Critical Workers

6:30am-5:30pm, \$29/Day

What locations are open?

Carlos Elementary School

Voyager Elementary School

Lincoln Elementary School

Woodland Elementary School/Early Education Center (*Preschool only available at Early Education Center)

How do I register for the program?

Please [register for the program by 8am](#), 3 days prior (36 hours) to beginning. Thirty dollar (\$30) registration fee has been waived.

Will my child receive breakfast and lunch?

Yes, **FREE** cooks' choice of breakfast and lunch will be served to ALL students in our care at, CES, VES, WES, LES and EEC.

What health precautions are taking place?

We will be requiring parents/guardians and students to use a hand disinfectant (we supply) upon entry and exit daily. We will also be doing health checks on all students, including daily temperature readings and a verbal questionnaire upon entry.

What will the ratios be while in care?

Ratios will be **1 adult:5 students or less** to provide social distancing for adults.

How will my child get to and from the childcare program?

You may drop your child off and pick up or you may choose District transportation (at no cost).
