Compass, School Age Childcare provides a warm, relaxed, and caring environment where enrolled Alexandria Public School students PreK-5th grade have the opportunity to pursue their own interests, develop friendships, and grow in confidence, independence and respect for themselves and others.

Compass offers an enriched and fun environment, professional caring staff along with a diverse curriculum including creative arts, literature, science and math. We also engage our students with recreational choices including gym time, outdoor play, large and small group games, and a balance between structured activities and self-directed learning.

Program sites include Carlos, Garfield, Miltona, Lincoln, Voyager and Woodland Elementary Schools and the Early Education Center.

### **Registration**

- Non-refundable annual \$30 family registration fee.
- Confirmation email will be sent upon acceptance.
- Preschoolers must be completely toilet-trained and self-sufficient in the bathroom.

### **Consistent Contract**

Same days of each week; you may not remove days and will be charged for all days whether your student attends or not.

### **Contract Changes/Withdrawal from Program**

Any contract changes, including withdrawal, must be made via online account before invoiced. Re-enrollment requires new registration and \$30 re-registration fee.

### **Non-School Days (NSD)**

- Available for 4 year olds to grade 5
- 6:30 AM - 5:30 PM at Woodland Elementary School & Early Education Center
- NSD phone: 320-762-3307
- Register via online account under NSD. (Any registration after the deadline will result in an additional \$2 charge for the day)
- Parents are responsible for sending lunch, 2 snacks, water bottle, reading book and appropriate outdoor clothing.

### **Scheduled 2-Hour Late Starts**

- September 30, February 3 and April 28
- Register via online account under NSD (All students must register, including AM contracts). (Any registration after the deadline will result in an additional \$2 charge for the day).
- No refunds after invoice sent.

**Billing**

- Emailed Thursdays, one week prior care, with payment due Monday by 9:00 am.
- Online payments can be made any time prior to the deadline.
- Auto-debit accounts charged Monday mornings.
- \$20 late payment fee incurs Monday, 9:00 am
- Accounts not paid in full by Friday will result in suspension of child care.
- Reinstatement requires outstanding payments, current invoice and \$30 re-registration fee.
- No refunds after invoice sent.

**Financial Assistance**

Compass accepts the Childcare Assistance Program (CCAP). Parents are responsible for payment until CCAP eligibility notification is received. Copayments and non-covered amounts are due 2 days after bi-weekly invoice. Payments received after due date will result in \$20 late payment fee. See CCAP payment schedule for exact dates.

**Flex Spending Accounts**

Log into online account to download receipts and print.

**Tax Statements**

Available after January 1st and may be downloaded from your account. Parents who will be filing taxes separately should have separate online accounts.

**Sign In and Out Procedures**

Adult must sign in and out daily. Requests to add authorized pick-up names may be made in writing or via email to brajdl@alexschools.org. Court orders are required for those with prohibited student access or dictated parenting time changes.

**Food**

Breakfast is available for students K-5 via family meal account after Compass is dismissed. Snacks are included in the afternoons. Parents must send bag lunches and snacks for non-school days.

**Electronics/Toys/Valuables**

All valuables, electronic devices, toys, cards and games should remain at home.

**Student Clothing**

We require jackets, snow pants, boots, mittens and hats. Flip-flops are discouraged.

# Health Information

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## **Illness/Emergency/Medications**

Please keep your student home if they show the following symptoms within 24 hours of care: fever, diarrhea, vomiting, green discharge from nose, sore throat, undiagnosed rash and/or non treatment for lice. District health nurse or professionals are not on staff during Compass hours.

If students becomes ill or injured:

- Student may rest in a supervised quiet area.
- First Aid will be administered.
- Parent/Guardians/Emergency Contacts will be notified immediately and be asked to pick up child.
- When necessary, 911 will be contacted to assist.

Compass will notify parent/legal guardian of an exposure the same day the program is notified of a reported contagious disease: scabies, impetigo, ringworm, or chicken pox.

Compass will notify parents of an exposure by posting information of the contagious disease in a conspicuous space that includes the illness, symptoms, treatment, preventative measures, and how many cases have been reported.

## **Allergy Care**

A list of any allergies must be provided to the Site. Please include any specific triggers, avoidance techniques, and symptoms of an allergic reaction that are specific to your child. If an allergic reaction may occur, we will follow appropriate procedures to the reaction which may include medication as prescribed by their physician. Staff will have information on site and for field trips of all students allergy information.

## **Medications**

An Authorization for Dispensing Medication (ADM) form must be completed if your child requires oral medication, an asthma inhaler or an Epi Pen during Compass hours. Community Education will determine if we are able to administer the medication. Medications must be in original packaging with prescription labels.

District health nurse or professionals are not on staff during Compass hours.

If medication is approved for dispensing, Compass will ensure all medicine is:

- Kept in the medicine's original container with a legible label stating the child's first and last name.
- Given only to the child whose name is on the label not given after an expiration date on the label.
- Returned to the child's parent or legal guardian or destroyed, if unused.  
Compass will document in the child's record the administration of medication, including:
- Child's first and last name.
- Name of the medication or prescription number.
- Date, time, and dosage; and name and signature of the person who administered the medicine.

Compass will store medicines and insect repellents according to directions on the original container.

# Rules of Behavior & Expectations

## **Rules of Behavior & Expectations**

Compass believes in supporting students through a positive reinforcement model. Students expectations are to follow Alexandria Public Schools Code of Conduct.

### **Alexandria Public Schools Code of Conduct:**

Respect:	of self, others, their beliefs and property
Honesty:	be truthful
Kindness:	be caring, friendly and helpful
Responsibility:	be dependable and accountable
Fairness:	be committed to the just treatment of others

### **Discipline Procedures**

The general policy of Alexandria Public Schools Community Education is to utilize progressive discipline to the extend reasonable and appropriate based upon the specific facts and circumstances of student misconduct. The form of discipline chosen in a particular case is solely with the discretion of Community Education Administration.

- Verbal warning/loss of privileges/time away from group.
- Written discipline report and/or verbal communication with parent/guardian.
- Parent conference.
- Removal from program.
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### **Circumstances requiring Disciplinary action/procedures:**

- Behavior that directly/indirectly threatens students or staff (ex. Hitting, pushing, spitting, throwing objects, verbal threats, disrespectful language, inappropriate gestures, etc).
- Behaviors that cause destruction or misuse of property, including inappropriate internet/technology.
- Behaviors demonstrating lack of self-control (anger/outbursts, disrespect or refusal to follow directions) and/or leaving the group or property without permission.
- Behavior that could be perceived as sexual harassment or intimidation (verbal language/gestures/physical contact, etc).
- Behavior that comprises the physical and emotional safety of employees and students.

*Parent pickup may be requested.*

Consequences from behavior listed could be grounds for removal.

**Compass strives to meet the needs of all students; however, students may be removed when expectations are not met.**
