Student Eligibility

If I indicate on the Alexandria Public School Registration Form that my child is Native American, is my child automatically in the Title VII program?

No, but it helps out with our ability to track down potential students.

How do I get my child to qualify?

Obtain a Title VII 506 form from your child's school office. Fill out the one-time form (which is kept confidential according to federal regulations).

If I fill out a Title VII 506 form, does my child HAVE to receive academic services?

Absolutely not, it is up to the parent/guardian to make that decision. By filling out the form, the student simply meets the qualifications to receive and/or participate in their desired program(s). We encourage parents to fill out the form so that we can communicate with parents through our newsletter and website, monitor students, and continue to receive funding for our programs.

Program Overview
