### SOFTBALL - VARSITY

Tuesday night the Cardinals opened up Sections vs Detroit Lakes. Right away in the first inning the Cardinals didn't waste anytime scoring runs, putting up 8 in the first inning.

## **BASEBALL - B TREAM**

Yesterday the Cardinal B baseball team split a double-header with Moorhead at AAHS. Alex won the opener 6-1 behind solid pitching from Parker Converse and Lawton Ketelson and stellar defense. Converse worked out of a bases loaded jam in the second inning striking out a Spud with the bases loaded. In the third, after a lead-off walk, Converse got a great diving catch from center fielder Dean Lempka for the first out, then picked off the Spud runner at first for the second out and struck out their third hole hitter to get the Cards back into the dugout. Ketelson worked the final two frames allowing one run. Sam Anderson and Jacob Nicholson led the offense with two hits each. Converse, John Botzet, Cam O'Shea, Lempka and Ketelson also collected hits.

In game two, Moorhead took an early 4-0 lead with a run in the first and two in the second and another in the third. The Cards plated one in the bottom of the third and two more in the 4th to make it 4-3. The Spuds put up 3 runs on the scoreboard in the fifth off reliever Abe Paiari to make it 7-3. Alex came back

with a run in the final frame but fell short losing 7-4. Kyle Blankenship started on the mound for Alex and worked the first three innings allowing 4 runs on 4 hits, 4 walks and striking out 4. Pajari worked two innings allowing 3 runs on five hits, one walk and striking out one. Lucas Sprenger banded out two doubles from his lead- off spot and Thomas Kremer also collected two hits for Alex. Zach Richards and Carson Holte also hit safely for the Cardinals.

The Cards host Detroit Lakes tomorrow and Willmar on Friday to end their season. The team's record stands at 10-5.




## CROSS COUNTRY TEAM INFO MEETING

Coaches will be there to meet with the high school runners, and to update you on Summer running opportunities, dates, camps, and Logs.






## LUNCH to GO for AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES of EVENTS
