Here are SIX OPERATING LEVY FACTS every parent should know.

- We are one of the only school districts in the area without a voterapproved operating levy, which means we don't have the additional financial support that the majority of Minnesota communities provide to help operate our schools.
- 2 State education funding has not kept pace with inflation or increasing costs for the past 15 years and we are in the bottom 10% of all Minnesota school districts for general education funding.
- It was a unanimous school board decision after months of planning to place a phased-in operating levy request on the Nov. 5 ballot. We believe this is a conservative, financially responsible way to support our students and educational programs.
- We are only asking for what we need, when we need it the levy amount is phased in over a three year period rather than all at once.
- The tax impact is also phased in over three years so the average homeowner will see a less than \$10 per month increase in year one, followed by smaller increases in years two and three.
- If approved, the funding would help maintain the quality education we currently offer, while maintaining class sizes and important student programs and supports.
